

## PRIVACY STATEMENT PROLUTION

In the context of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Prolution has drawn up a privacy statement. This privacy statement describes which personal data we process for various purposes, how we handle these personal data and how you can apply your rights with regard to your personal data.

### PROCESSED PERSONAL DATA

Prolution may process personal data about you, because you use the services of Prolution and/or because you provide Prolution with the personal data when filling out a contact form on the website.

Prolution can process the following personal data:

- Your first and last name
- Your phone number
- Your email address
- Your IP address

### WHY PROLUTION NEEDS THE PERSONAL DATA

Prolution processes the personal data to be able to contact you by telephone if you request it, and/or to be able to contact you in writing (by e-mail and/or by post) if you can't be reached by telephone.

In addition, Prolution may use your personal data in the context of performing an agreement of assignment concluded with you.

### HOW LONG PROLUTION STORES THE PERSONAL DATA

Prolution does not store your personal data longer than strictly necessary to achieve the goals for which your data is collected. Your data will not be stored for more than a year if there is no agreement with you.

### SHARE WITH THIRD PARTIES

Prolution will only provide your personal data to third parties if this is necessary for the execution of an agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation.

### MAPPING WEBSITE VISIT

On the website of Prolution general visitor information is kept, including the IP address of your computer and the time of the retrieval and data that your browser sends. This data will be used for analyses of visitor and click behaviour on the website. Prolution uses this information to improve the operation of the website. This data will be anonymised as much as possible and will not be provided to third parties.

## GOOGLE ANALYTICS

Prolution uses Google Analytics to track how users use the website and how effective the Adwords ads from Prolution on Google search result pages are. The information thus obtained, including the address of your computer (IP address), is transferred to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Read Google's privacy policy for more information. You also find the privacy policy of Google Analytics here.

Google uses this information to keep track of how the website of Prolution is used, to provide reports on the website to Prolution and to provide its advertisers with information about the effectiveness of their campaigns. Google may provide this information to third parties of Google is legally obliged to do so or insofar as these third parties process the information on behalf of Google. Prolution has no influence on this. Prolution has not granted Google permission to use Analytics information obtained through Prolution for other Google services.

## VIEW DATA, CUSTOMIZE DATA OR REMOVAL OF DATA

You have the right to see, customize or delete your personal data. You can send a request for access, correction or removal to [marie-an@prolution.nl](mailto:marie-an@prolution.nl). Prolution will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within four weeks.

## PROTECT

Prolution takes the protection of your personal data seriously and has taken appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized modification. The website of Prolution uses a reliable SSL Certificate to ensure that your personal data will not fall into the wrong hands.
